

# Accomplishments to Date: Landfills / Lagoons

Under the Environmental Management Program, the U.S. Department of Energy has closed all five landfills on-site in accordance with regulatory requirements. These landfills cover a total of 60 acres and long-term surveillance and maintenance monitoring of the landfills continues today. The landfills were used for the disposal of a variety of wastes such as construction debris, low-level contaminated scrap materials, hazardous materials, classified materials, and sanitary wastes.
